With support provided by the Kids Cancer Care Foundation, we announce a grant competition to provide support for Allied Health and Nursing professionals to develop research focused on the care of infants, children, adolescents and young adults who have been diagnosed with cancer and their families.

The focus is to encourage staff at a <u>novice level</u> to engage in research initiatives that have the potential for significant impact on clinical care.

The total amount available for this funding opportunity is \$25,000. Individual requests between \$5,000 and not exceeding \$10,000 will be accepted.

Application Guidelines

- Trainees and/or staff of the Alberta Children's Hospital, Charbonneau and ACHRI are eligible to apply. It can be a single investigator, collaboration or a group.
- Identification of a research mentor is a critical component of this opportunity. Mentors need not be identified at the Letter of Intent stage. Opportunities to partner successful applicants with a mentor exist with the support of the funding organization.

Letter of Intent (Maximum 2 pages)

Submit a concise description of your proposed project using the criteria outlined below.

Rationale (Concept, Significance, Impact)

Is the idea creative?

Does it address a knowledge gap?

Does it have potential to advance child health outcomes?

Questions/Objectives

Are the goals and objectives well defined?

Approaches and Methods

Are the approaches and methods appropriate to deliver the proposed outcomes, outputs, or impacts?

Are the timelines and deliverables realistic?

Knowledge Translation

Is the knowledge translation plan well-defined and appropriate to the scope of the project?
