

Birds in your Yard!

There are lots of birds out singing. Make this easy bird feeder and watch them come and visit for snack time!

You will need

- 2/3 cup of boiling water
- 2 packets of gelatin
- 2 cups of bird seed
- Wax paper
- Cookie cutters
- Twine or string
- Straws cut into 2-inch pieces



Carefully pour the water into a mixing bowl. Add the gelatin and stir until it's fully dissolved. Add the bird seed and mix well.

Place cookie cutters onto a wax paper-lined tray and scoop seed mixture in until heaping full. Place another piece of wax paper on top of the cookie cutters and press down firmly to pack in all the seeds. Remove the top paper and gently poke straw pieces all the way through the seed shapes (not too close to the edges). Place the tray into the fridge for a couple of hours then let it sit on the counter to dry out. A few hours later, flip the cookie cutters over to let the bottoms dry out too. Let it sit overnight until the feeders are completely dry. Remove the seed shapes from the cutters (they should be fully dry and hard to the touch). Remove the straws and tie a twine loop through the holes and hang in a tree. How many different types of birds will stop by to say hi?



Ooey Gooey Grilled Cheese!

We all love grilled cheese sammies here at Camp Kindle! Here is a delicious twist to make them extra cheesy and delicious! Makes 4.

Ingredients

8 slices of your favourite bread

8 slices of cheddar cheese

8 slices of mozza cheese (or your favourite kind)

Cheese spread

½ cup cream cheese

½ cup shredded cheddar

2 tablespoons of cream


¼ teaspoon salt



- 1. Combine the cheese spread ingredients in a food processor and blend until smooth.
- 2. Lay out 2 pieces of bread. Place a slice of cheddar on one piece and a slice of mozza on the other.
- 3. Spoon a quarter of the cheese spread on the cheddar and smooth it out then press the cheddar and mozza side together
- 4. Spread butter on the outside of the sandwich and grill sandwich for two minutes on each side until cheese is melted and bread is golden brown,
- 5. Enjoy!
