Walking Water Rainbow

Supplies you'll need

- Six wide mouth glasses or jars
- Paper towels
- Food dye or liquid watercolors — red, yellow and blue

Both small and large glasses work, but remember that bigger glasses will need more food coloring.

Preparing your paper towel strips

Rip off six sheets of paper towel and fold each sheet in thirds lengthwise. It's a good idea to test your paper towel strip to make sure it fits properly in your glasses. They should be able to go from the bottom of one jar to the bottom of the next without sticking up in the air too much. The paper towel on the right shows good heights.



Making a rainbow

First, line up the glasses and fill the first one with a good squirt of red watercolor, the third with yellow, and the fifth glass with blue. Leave the other glasses empty.

Next, add water to the glasses with color until the colored water almost reaches the top of the glass.

Move the glasses into a circle and add the paper towel. Starting with the red, add one end of the paper towel to the glass and then put the other end in the empty glass next to it. Continue around until the last paper towel is placed into the red glass.

Now, sit back and enjoy the show.



Make a Camp Kindle favourite — Haystacks!

Ingredients

- 2 Cups white sugar
- 1/3 cup unsweetened cocoa powder
- 1/2 Cup milk
- 1/2 Cup butter, softened
- 3 ½ Cups Quick Cooking Oats
- 1 Cup flaked coconut
- 1 pinch Salt



1. In a saucepan bring sugar, cocoa, milk and butter to a boil. Remove from heat.
2. Stir in oats, coconut and salt.
3. Drop quickly onto wax paper with a teaspoon.
4. Let cool.

We are looking forward to camp turning from brown to green!

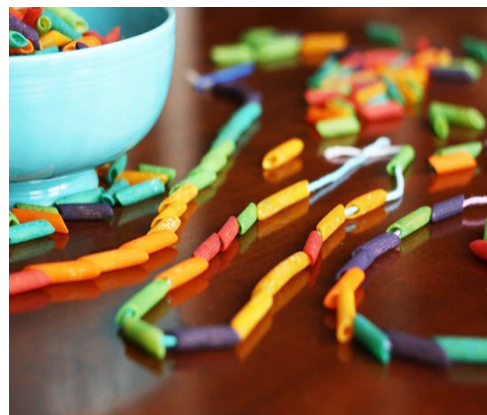

What You'll Need

- Uncooked pasta (choose a hollow pasta, like penne, if making necklaces)
- Food coloring
- Vinegar
- Plastic containers with lids (or re-sealable food storage bags)
- Cookie rack
- Yarn or string

How to dye your pasta in 4 simple steps

1. Place 2 handfuls or 2 cups of pasta in a food container.
2. In a small bowl, mix together 1 tsp of vinegar with a generous dab of icing gel or several drops of food colouring. (Do each colour one at a time. No mixing! Unless you really want to!)
3. Pour the vinegar/icing gel mixture over the pasta, seal the container, and now for the fun part, have your child SHAKE IT like crazy, until the pasta is well coated. (Hint: purple pasta must always be done twice; re-coat immediately, while still wet).
4. Pour the pasta out in a single layer onto a cookie sheet to dry.
5. Tie one piece of pasta on to the end of the yarn to prevent the pasta from slipping off and begin adding the pasta to the yarn in whatever order you would like.
6. Once you're happy with your creation, un-tie that first piece of pasta you secured in place\ and knot both ends of the yarn together.
